- (b) Draw a pie-chart to represent the population of East Africa in 2009. (05marks)
- (c) (i) Identify the country in East Africa with the highest percentage population change between 2005 and 2009. (01mark)
- (ii) Describe the factors which have contributed to the population change in the country identified in (c) (i) above. (06marks)
- (d) Explain the effects of a high population growth rate in East Africa. (05marks)
